

This is a useful guide for absolute beginners and experienced stitchers looking for a little help or to refresh their memories. Learn the essential techniques and then try out what you've discovered by working on the 39 practical projects inside. Projects include: Animals, Figures, Nature, Plants and Flowers and there are photo guides for all.

[Inspirations Studios] Explore general embroidery with 12 fabulous projects reflecting Margaret's passion for travel and the decorative arts. The designs include striking combinations of colour and stitch, using wool and silk threads on linen and cotton fabrics. Follow the steps to embroider projects such as decorative panels and tiles. needlework accessories, and a bag and jewellery roll utilising a felt-inlay technique from 19th century Iranian



textiles. The book also includes a library of over 70 stitches.

HOPE BRASFIELD [Quarto] Satisfying Stitches is perfect for embroidery beginners. Discover the stress-relieving benefits of embroidery while stitching fun, modern, vibrant designs such as flowers, plants, animals, landscapes, and celestial scenes. There are options once you've gained confidence for adding interest and texture too.
